In 2012 the league of MSF held 29 regattas, 11 sport classes and 18 crusaders. The Montenegrin sailors participated in 15 regattas abroad and won 5 gold, 3 silver and 1 copper medals. The greatest success of the Montenegrin sailing in 2012 was the placement of Milivoj Dukic on the Olympic Games in London and winning the 30<sup>th</sup> place among 49 best sailors of the world in the class Laser Standard, placement of Milivoj Dukic in top 100 in the world rang list in the class Laser Standard, silver medal for Milivoj Dukic at the Open European Junior Competition held in Nieuwpoort in Belgium in the class Laser Standard, the fifth place of Igor Les at the Balkan competition in the class Laser Standard held in Galaxydy in Greece, the second place of Dusan Bogdanovic at the Split Olympic week in the class Laser Radial in Croatia, the first lace of Igor Les and the third place of Matija Grabic at the regatta of Euro cup in the class Laser Radial and the ninth place of Todor Tusup in the class Laser 4.7 held in Lugano in Switzerland, the twelfth place of Igor Les at the European Senior competition in the class Laser Radial and the twenty sixth place of Milivoj Dukic in class Laser Standard Senior held in Hourtin in France, the first place in the class crusader at the South-Dalmatian regatta of skipper Sasa Kekovic with his boat "Black Mistery" and the second place in Mrduja among over to hundred boats from Adriatic.

Montenegro was a host of two great international crusaders regattas "Terra di mare" with 51 crusaders from Italy and the traditional one called "Fasinada", while in open classes there were open championship of Montenegro and Montenegro Cup with great number of competitors from Montenegro and region.

On regattas and preparations in Montenegro there were many competitors from Croatia, Serbia, Macedonia, Albania, Italy, Switzerland, England, Russia, Germany, Poland and we are convinced that the number of countries coming to Montenegro for sailing shall be increased. We shall continue with the promotion of nautical potentials of Montenegro and represent our sport in dignified manner.

In 2012 over two hundred children completed sailing school where we provided motor, emotional, psychological and social development of children. Sailing is a sport directly connected with nature where children can individually manage the sails.

Being in a clean sea air, direct contact with natural elements, development of self-discipline and independence, responsibility, skill of decision-making, development of all motor skills, coordination, balance, flexibility, speed are only few of the skills that children can acquire in this sport.

In 2012 our sailors participated in regattas in Croatia, Italy, France, Slovenia, Switzerland, England, Belgium, Germany, Austria and Greece.
